

DEFENSIVE HANDGUN COURSE III

INTERMEDIATE HANDGUN SKILLS

8 Hour Course – 2 Hours Classroom and 6 Hours Range Time

Course Cost \$320.00

Pre-Requisite: Handgun Course II

Student Requirements: Serviceable Handgun, eye protection, ear protection, 500 rounds of ammo, extra mags, holster and mag pouches, tactical or carry belt, ball cap and comfortable clothing. Dress for weather conditions.

At the conclusion of this course, the student will acquire intermediate defensive handgun skills and have a better understanding of the required skills, their implementation and the necessary requirements to maintain these skills for implementation. This course stresses the importance of effectively completing the handgun manipulation skills; it presents new skills, and, at this level, enhanced marksmanship is demanded of all students as a standard for defensive shooting. Again, this course may present the student with specific skills that may require further development in order to maintain and implement the proper knowledge, skills and attitude for effective defensive shooting. This course will provide emphasis on:

- Brief review of Handgun Course II
- Range Drills for warm up
- Scenario based training utilizing the handgun manipulation skills learned in HG II
- Post scenario evaluations
- Enhance strong hand and support hand shooting
- Engaging while using cover and/or concealment
- Introduction to shooting while moving
- Introduction to shooting in non-conventional positions
- Introduction to non-conventional handgun manipulation skills
